Registration is open, please submit an abstract (maximum 300 words) by May 15, 2023.

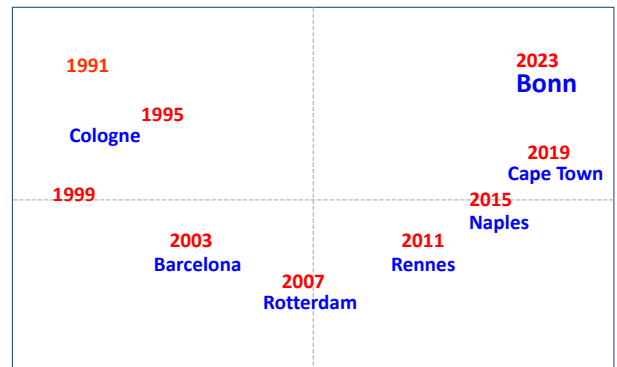
Deadline for abstract submission: extended to May 30, 2023
