Annual Conference of Experimental Sociology (ACES) 2025

August 27-29, 2025 | Leipzig University, Germany

The 7th *Annual Conference of Experimental Sociology* (ACES) will take place for the first time in Germany, hosted by Leipzig University from **August 27-29, 2025**. The venue is located at the Bibliotheca Albertina (Beethovenstr. 6, D-04107 Leipzig).

ACES provides a platform for the presentation, exchange, and discussion of experimental research in sociology and the broader social sciences. At its core, experimental research identifies causal social mechanisms by contrasting a treatment group with a comparable control group. This conference welcomes contributions employing diverse research designs, including laboratory experiments, survey experiments, field experiments, and natural experiments.

Beside the regular presentation and a possible poster session, keynote speeches will be given by Sonja Vogt (University of Lausanne / University of Oxford) and Andreas Diekmann (ETH Zurich / Leipzig University). Furthermore, a panel discussion on the connecting lines between experimental research and Computational Social Science is planned.

We invite sociologists and scholars of related fields to submit an abstract (max. 500 words) for a presentation or poster on the ACES 2025 by **April 6, 2025**.
