Sociology and Methods of Quantitative Social Research
(Bes.Gr. W3 LBesG)**

beginning October 1st, 2019.

Applicants are expected to demonstrate theoretical and methodological competencies as well as appropriate teaching and research experience in quantitative methods of social research and a substantive field of sociology. The Institute of Sociology seeks an extension of its sociological areas of research, preferably "migration and ethnicity" or "economy and labor". The successful candidate covers this substantive field of sociology as well as quantitative research methods including statistics in their full breadth and is responsible for teaching both areas in the bachelor and master program of sociology. Introductory courses must be held in German language, advanced courses in German or English language. The necessary language skills are considered a prerequisite. Applicants should be committed to the Institute of Sociology as a multi-paradigmatic institution comprising theoretical sociology and qualitative social research.

In addition to the doctorate, outstanding scientific achievements and international visibility can be demonstrated through publications and experience in raising third-party funds. Collaboration in one of the JGU's main research areas is expressly encouraged.

Applicants must meet the general requirements according to public services law and the Higher Education Act of Rhineland-Palatinate.

The State of Rhineland-Palatinate and Johannes Gutenberg-University of Mainz are committed to intensive personal mentoring of students and, therefore, expect a strong presence of teaching staff at the University.
