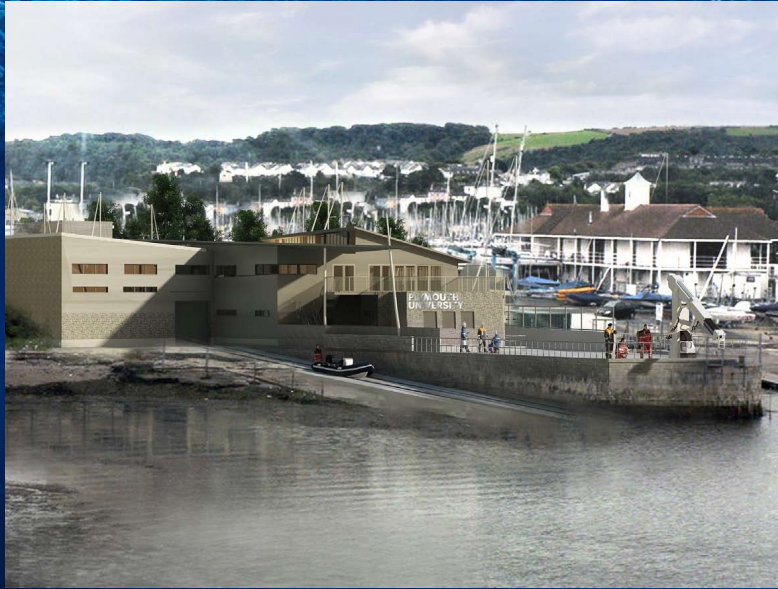

PLYMOUTH UNIVERSITY MARINE STATION

Ready for summer 2014, Plymouth University is carrying out a complete £4.6m redevelopment of its waterfront campus. The new Marine Station will provide modern facilities to support our internationally recognised marine teaching and research.

Situated at Coxside, the Marine Station is at the heart of Plymouth's historic waterfront, next door to the National Marine Aquarium and only a 25 minutes walk from the Main Campus.

With classrooms, wet laboratory, aquarium, equipment stores and changing facilities, the Marine Station will provide a base for students and researchers to conduct multidisciplinary academic work within the Plymouth Sound and Estuaries Special Area of Conservation.

This work is further supported by our boat fleet (including our 14m research vessel *Falcon Spirit* and 44ft sail-training vessel *Take the Helm*), extensive field sampling equipment, ROVs and professional dive team.
